



COURTNEY FARECHART HELPER

Here is an easy to understand explanation of how to read a farechart.

Each farechart is shown as a grid. The easiest way to find your fare is as follows;

1. Find your **departure point** and your **target destination or nearest point** on the grid.
2. Follow the line on the grid from each of your points of travel and until they meet (the amount in the grid is always an Adult Single fare).
3. This will be your fare. Use the chart below the grid (explained below in example) if you need a return fare or child fare.

The difference between a Maidenhead and a Network ticket is you cant use a Maidenhead ticket outside of Maidenhead. A Network is for use of our Windsor and Hurley/Henley services. See box on example above.

The amount on the farechart is always the Adult Single fare. The chart below the grid shows AS (Adult Single), AR (Adult Return), CS (Child Single) and CR (Child Return).

For example; You're travelling from Windsor to St Marks Hospital—the fare on the grid is £3.30 AS. And you want to know how much it is for an Adult Return fare.

You then look at the chart below the grid and find the AS fare, you can then see what the AR fare is and also child fares, if any, that may be travelling.

Please note: As stated on our website: Child fares are from the age of 5-15. 16+ is classed as an adult fare.

Simple as that!
